The facility is subject to unannounced compliance inspections throughout the year to verify this continued compliance.

If you wish to add other sources or materials to the materials considered eligible, the materials and suppliers must be approved beforehand. Please note that any ruminant-origin ingredients (other than dairy-origin ingredients and tallow containing a maximum level of insoluble impurities of 0.15%) used in the manufacture of pet food exported to Malaysia must be sourced from the United States, Australia, and/or New Zealand. Laboratory test results showing the protein free tallow (maximum level of insoluble impurities of 0.15% in weight) must be submitted with the health certificate for endorsement.

Lastly, I would like to remind you that the facility must complete the renewal process no later than July 17, 2025. Please contact this office no later than three months prior to this date to initiate the re-approval process.
